

**CDLI Mid-Course Exam Schedule & Guidelines 2025-2026**

- This exam schedule only applies to courses being offered through CDLI.
- Students are encouraged to take home belongings needed for studying several days in advance of their scheduled exam.
- Any student with an ROA is entitled to the appropriate exam accommodations as noted in the student's IEP and/or ROA.
- If a school is closed during the exam period (half-day or full-day), the exams scheduled that day will move to the end of the exam period. For example, if a school is closed on January 26th, 2026, exams on that day will be moved to Monday, February 2nd, 2026. If a school is closed on January 26th and 27th, exams will be moved to Monday, February 2nd, and Tuesday, February 3rd, 2026. If the school is only closed in the morning, then only the morning exams will be moved to the next week.
- Individual schools impacted by school closures are asked to consult with CDLI teachers should their school close when a CDLI exam is expected to take place.

**Mid-Course Exams / Assessments**

- Exams/assessments are one hour in length.
- For the AM session, the suggested time is 9:00 AM - 10:00 AM.
- For the PM session, the suggested time is 1:00 PM - 2:00 PM.
- While no new instruction or assessment will occur during the exam period, teachers will be available to students in their Zoom links at their regularly scheduled class time.
- Second-chance opportunities for Mid-Course exams will take place the week of February 16th - 20th. Our regularly scheduled classes will occur during this time. Teachers will reach out to coordinate scheduling the reassessment for those students who sign up. More information to follow.
