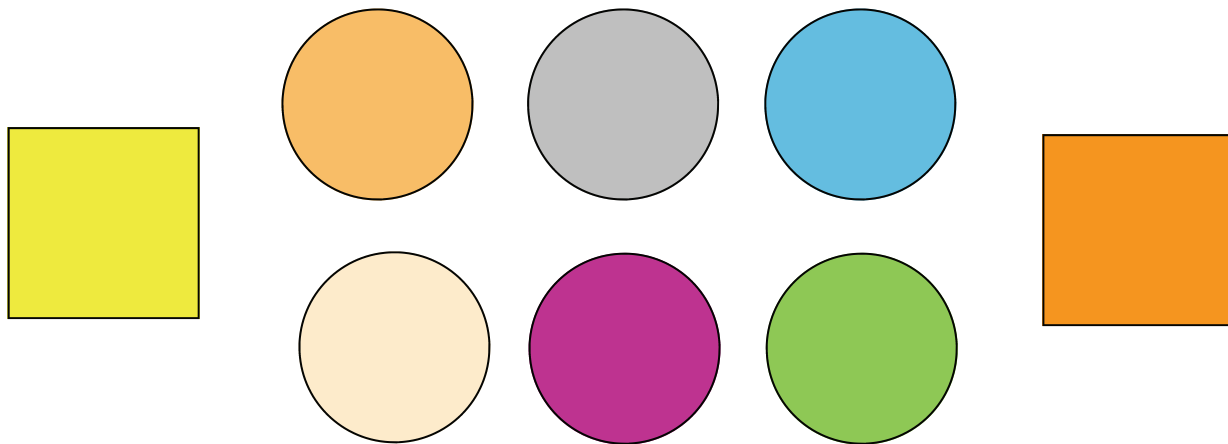


One Teach, One Observe



Notes

- ◆ **Supportive**
- ◆ **One teacher leads the lesson and one teacher observes for a specific reason.**
- ◆ **Low level of planning/preparation.**
- ◆ **Decisions should be made in advance as to what information is to be gathered and how.**
- ◆ **Both teachers analyze the gathered information together.**

Applications

- **New co-teaching situations.**
- **To investigate particular questions about the student's learning environment.**
- **To monitor student progress.**
- **Effectiveness of cooperative groups.**
- **To note which students begin or do not begin work promptly.**
- **Impact of physical classroom environment on student learning.**
- **To observe which supports are effective in assisting a student.**
