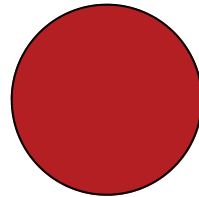
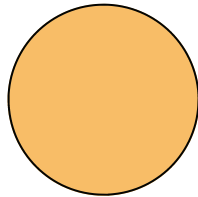
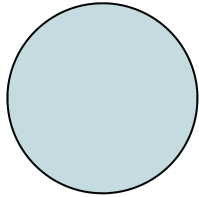
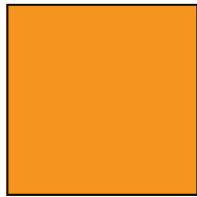
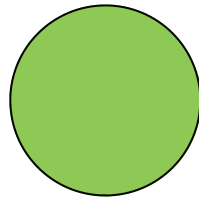
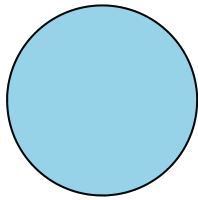
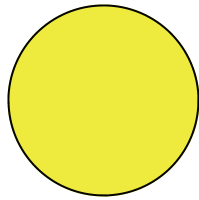
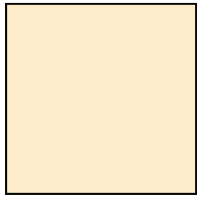


# Team Teaching



## Notes

- ◆ **Both teachers deliver the same instruction at the same time.**
- ◆ **Each speaks freely during large group instruction and moves among all students.**
- ◆ **Instruction becomes a conversation not turn taking.**
- ◆ **Requires the highest degree of trust and collaboration between teachers.**
- ◆ **Most complex model yet most satisfying way to co-teach.**
- ◆ **High level of planning/preparation.**
- ◆ **The approach that is most dependent on meshing of teachers' styles.**

## Applications

- **When students are not extremely diverse in readiness levels for the lesson or topic.**
- **When teachers have considerable experience and a high familiarity with the topic and each other.**
- **When the goal of instruction is to demonstrate some type of interaction such as role play or formal debate.**
- **One teacher explains while the other demonstrates.**
