

CDLI Self-Registration Course Tutorial

This tutorial is broken into **three** parts:

- Part 1: Creation of a CDLI account (necessary in order to enroll in the courses).
- Part 2: Self Registration courses and how to access them (2A and 2B)
- Part 3: Learning Resources Materials

Part 1: Creating a CDLI Account

- 1. Open your internet browser and visit CDLI's website <u>https://www.cdli.ca</u>
- 2. Near the top right of the page are the words "Sign Up" (see below). Click on it.



3. Enter a valid email address in the box and click "Create My Account"

Part 2A: Self Registration Courses

To register for a course, follow the steps below.

- Log in to your CDLI account by going to <u>https://www.cdli.ca</u> and clicking on "Login". Enter the Username and password created during Part 1 above. Your username and password would have been sent to your email.
- 2. After you log in you will be presented with a screen similar to the one noted below.

4. Click on Self Registration. A new window appears (see below).

5. Click the <u>Thumbnail</u> of the course in which you wish to enroll or alternatively, click in the search box to look for a course (if you do not see a thumbnail). See pic above.

6. A new window appears. Click Enroll in Course.





7. Confirm your registration in the course and click **OK**.



8. Return to the **BrightSpace** homepage (Click on the Centre for Distance Learning and Innovation words at the top of the screen)

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9. You should now see your new course in the My Courses area.



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Part 2B: Accessing Course Content/Lessons

To gain access to lessons follow the steps below.

- 1. Login to our website <u>www.cdli.ca</u> using your username and password.
- 2. Click on "BrightSpace" link (top right of screen).
- 3. Select your course (thumbnail) from the My Courses widget/area. A new screen will appear. We have selected World History for our course.



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5. A new screen appears showing a table of contents for the lessons. Click on a section/ lesson to open it.



6. Your lesson should be visible or start to play.





Note: If you see the screen below after clicking on a lesson, then do either of the following to correct issue:

- a. Check to see if you have Adobe Flash Player installed and it is working.
- b. Choose a different Browser (Firefox, Chrome etc) to see if it will work.

Part 3: Accessing Learning Resources

To access CDLI's learning resources follow these steps.

a. Go to <u>www.cdli.ca</u> and login to your account.
